PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- In 2008, the famous California based In-n-Out Burger restaurant began its expansion into the Utah market. The company sought out local design firms and McNeil Engineering was commissioned as their civil engineering and landscape architectural consultant.
- From the beginning, McNeil Engineering's landscape architectural design team worked closely with INO's headquarters to develop landscape design concepts and standards that would become the theme for all of their restaurants in Utah. To complement the theme of the restaurant and signage, the palette consisted of plants that are white, red and yellow. The vision was to create a bright, lively and colorful landscape that would not only be aesthetically pleasing to the customers, but provide year round interest.
- In an effort to conserve water and be sensitive to the environment, the irrigation system consisted of below grade inline drip emitters for both the planting beds as well as the lawn areas. The system is controlled by a ET based smart controller complete with rain sensor, flow sensor and fertilizer injector. To date, McNeil Engineering has been involved in over a dozen different sites scattered throughout the Wasatch Front.
