Landscape Architecture Project



- Washington Terrace City is located in the south portion of Weber County and is adjacent to the City of Ogden, Utah. This City of approximately 8,551 residents (2000 Census) and encompassing an area of approximately 4.47 Square Kilometers (1.7 Square Miles) commissioned this Parks and Open Space Master Plan in the fall of 2001. The purpose for the plan included; an inventory of the existing parks, park equipment, and other open space areas in the City. Additionally, the plan was to identify needed improvements for the existing parks, identify potential new park and open space areas, and identify potential trail corridors and ties to a countywide trail system. McNeil Engineering developed a process for the Parks and Open Space Master Plan that included Analysis of Existing Parks and Equipment; Public Input and Citizen Participation; Comparison of National Standards and Community Needs; Identification of Future Park and Open Space Needs; Trails Master Plan; Identification of Projects; Project Costs; and Plan Adoption.
- This process and the final product provided the necessary information so McNeil Engineering could prepare the essence and the intent of the plan, which was to provide the City with a schedule of immediate improvements for the parks, future park area and improvements, and cost estimates for these improvements over the next ten years.
- ♦ McNeil Engineering presented the plan to the City Council. After the public meeting, the City Council made a motion to adopt the plan by resolution, thus, adding the Parks and Open Space Master Plan as an element of the City's General Plan
